

HOMEBOUND MEAL DRIVERS WANTED

The homebound meal driver will transport meals to assigned recipients; complete daily logs and reports as required; properly handle, clean, and return hot bags and coolers to their assigned areas daily. Turn in contributions on a daily basis. Assist in kitchen with packaging of hot and cold food items as required. Use thermometer to record meal temperatures. Keep agency vehicles, delivery bags and other equipment clean at all times. Must understand and communicate the mission of the Muskingum County Center for Seniors Nutrition Program and abide by established guidelines. Other duties as required.

Requirements

Prefer high school graduate or equivalent. Must be able to keep accurate records and perform basic math. Previous work with the elderly helpful. Must follow state and local health department guidelines which apply to the job. Must be in good physical health, maintain good personal hygiene and be able to lift up to 50 pounds. Attend trainings as scheduled. Valid Ohio Driver's License is required. Will require standing for more than one hour, walking, sitting, bending, stooping, squatting, kneeling, twisting, reaching above your head, good range of motion in neck, good manual dexterity and coordination, stair climbing, and climbing in and out of a vehicle. Exposure to adverse climatic conditions is likely.

Interested candidates must have a valid driver's license and are subject to background checks.
